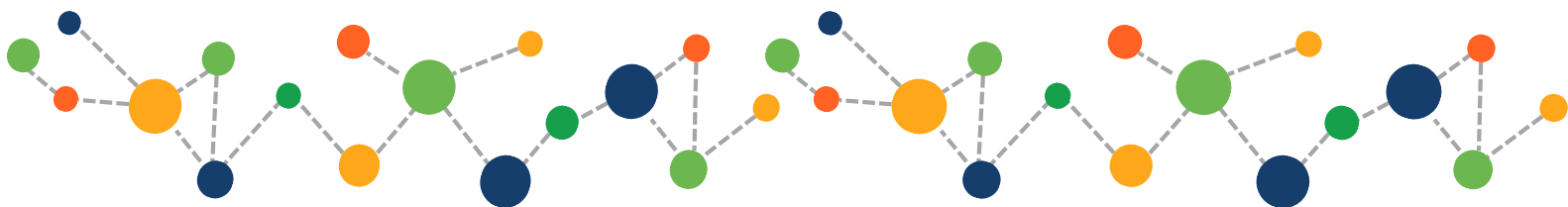


# Invitation to Join IRENE's Multi-actor Hub

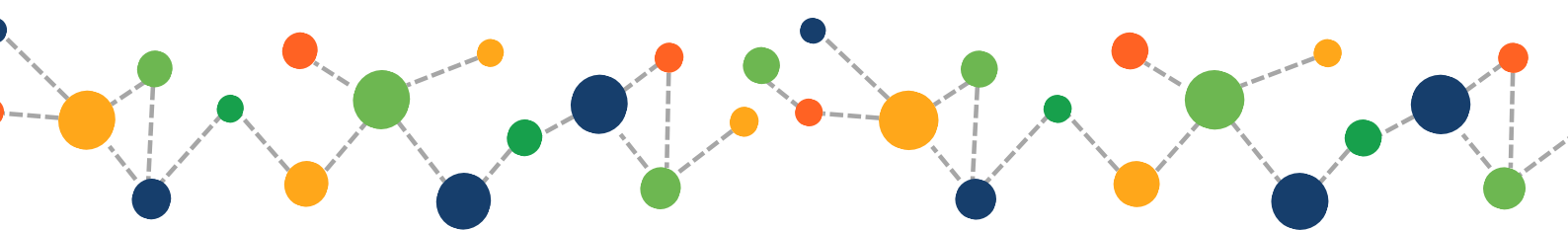

# ABOUT IRENE

Energy poverty remains a pressing challenge in the European Union, affecting millions of citizens and negatively impacting public health, social inclusion, and quality of life. IRENE is a LIFE-funded project that aims to promote **energy-efficiency improvements in multi-apartment buildings**, focusing on vulnerable populations, ensuring that no one is left behind in the energy transition.

Working in four cities, Vilvoorde and Leuven (Belgium), Vilnius (Lithuania), and Madrid (Spain), IRENE is built on strong local collaboration, bringing together **municipalities, community representatives, and technical experts** through multi-stakeholder groups in each city.

## OUR GOALS

-  Reduce **energy poverty** by promoting integral energy-efficiency renovations in multi-apartment buildings.
-  Reduce **energy consumption** and improve the **living conditions** of vulnerable households and neighbourhoods.
